Annual Report to the School Community Procedures Policy

Background

The Annual Report contains a performance summary, which provides overall results of students and how the school compares with other Victorian government schools, taking into account student intake.

Guidelines

Within the summary, parents/carers can access:

- *student outcome* results for the latest school year, as well as the last four years (where available) and a detailed breakdown of the result areas that were measured
- *school comparison* data, that identifies whether a school, taking into account its students, is performing higher than, lower than, or broadly similar to other schools.

Implementation

The report also contains the 'What Our School Is Doing' statement, which provides context for the data contained in each school's performance summary and outlines the school's achievements and plans for the future.

The Annual Report is provided to all School Councillors and other members of the school community who attend Annual General Meeting. A paper copy is available at the school office. It is also uploaded onto the school's website with a link through Compass.

The Annual Report is uploaded to the Strategic Planning Online Tool (SPOT)

Evaluation

School Council will review this policy every three years.

This policy was ratified at School Council on 26 th August 2020 and will be reviewed August 2023.
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
