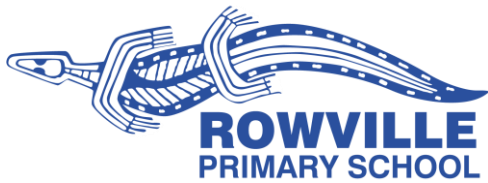

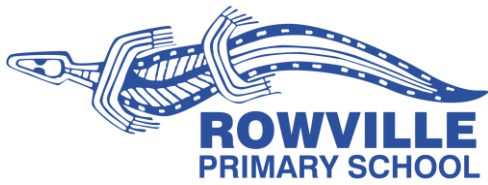
How do we protect personal and other information?
